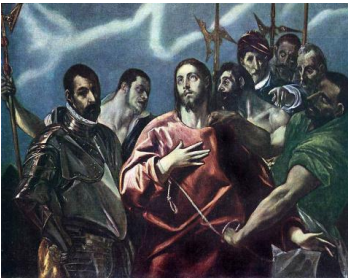
El Greco - Christ on the Cross Adored by Two Donors
