

Harriet Tubman (1820-1913)

"Conductor" on the Underground Railroad, called the "Moses" of Her People

Ripley was a town that hated slavery. Maybe Tice Davids, a Kentucky runaway slave, knew that as he reportedly swam for his life across the <u>Ohio River</u>.

His white master wasn't far behind. With his eyes fixed on his "property," the owner furiously rowed across the river which separated  $\underline{\text{free states}}$  (like Ohio) from  $\underline{\text{slave states}}$  (like Kentucky).

What happened next, according to legend, gave a name to a movement.


